

P2PROJECTS – Hazardous Events Mitigated

– MASTER LIST IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER

Successes:

- July 2003: A total of 478 PCB contaminated ballasts and 657 **fluorescent bulbs** (that contain **mercury**) were gathered from **Plum Brook** facility, surveyed out to show no radioactive contamination, and were then sent to the Plum Brook Station hazardous waste storage facility. They will be held there pending disposition through the normal channels. This effort avoids the need to dispose of this material as a mixed waste. Another, larger transfer will take place in the near future. Involved: Bob Lallier.

- November 2003: Oil spill to Guerin pond. A write-up is pending. Involved: Dan Papcke.

Work in Progress:

- July 2003: Plum Brook: Mike Bajorek has a **2000-gal oil-water separator** that could possibly be used at the SPF to help protect Kuebelar Ditch. (See also Hazardous Waste Events).
